"I have taught at the middle school level, summer school, assistant principal, elementary principal, associate superintendent, and superintendent," she said. "It's been a blessing."

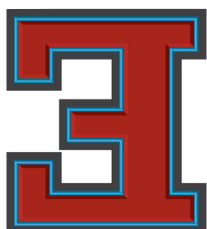

Colonel Sarah Babbitt Named Distinguished Alumnus for 2022

The Eastmont Foundation is proud to announce Col. Sarah Babbitt, Eastmont High School Class of 1996, as the Distinguished Alumnus for 2022.

While attending EHS, Sarah was active in Future Community Leaders and served as Treasurer. She was also a 1996 Apple Blossom Top Ten Royalty Candidate. She graduated from Washington State University in 2000 with a degree in Criminal Justice and was commissioned through the Air Force ROTC program. After 9/11, Sarah was among the first military personnel deployed in late September 2001 to Seeb Air Base in Muscat, Oman, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. Col. Babbitt also

attended the prestigious Naval War College in Newport, RI and has also achieved two Masters of Arts degrees and a Master of Science in National Security Studies.



Col. Babbitt's resume is extensive and impressive. Her commands have taken her to Texas, Arizona, South Korea, Utah, Guam, and even to Pullman, WA, to serve as a Unit Admissions Officer and Commandant of Cadets for their Air Force ROTC program.

In July of 2015, Col. Babbitt took command of the 18th Security Forces Squadron at Kadena Air Base, Okinawa, Japan. Comprised of 450 Security Forces personnel, it is the largest conventional

and her superintendent certificate from Washington State University.

"Honestly, all of that preparation is very important. It's important to know our history. It's important to know from the experts, but I think I probably learned the most teaching in middle school," she said. "I would like to say I have a doctorate in teaching middle school kids."

Most recently, she served three years overseas at the American Dubai. Before that, she was at the Marysville School District, and before that, the Deer Park School District near Spokane.

While she said it's too early to outline specific goals, her mission is to help students discover their promise, to partner with parents, and to model democracy in how we operate our schools.

She's also keenly focused on safety and the mental health of our students. "And we have a strategic plan that talks about learning and teaching that we will push forward," she said.



She said it's important for the district to partner with families. And she hopes parents get involved in their local schools, even if their children are in junior high or high school.

Berg said there's a rich legacy here, a legacy that takes generations to build, and she is thrilled to be a part of taking it to the next step.

"I just feel very blessed to be at Eastmont School District," she said. "We've got a good stable school board, we've got a good history of voters supporting the schools, and we have great pride."

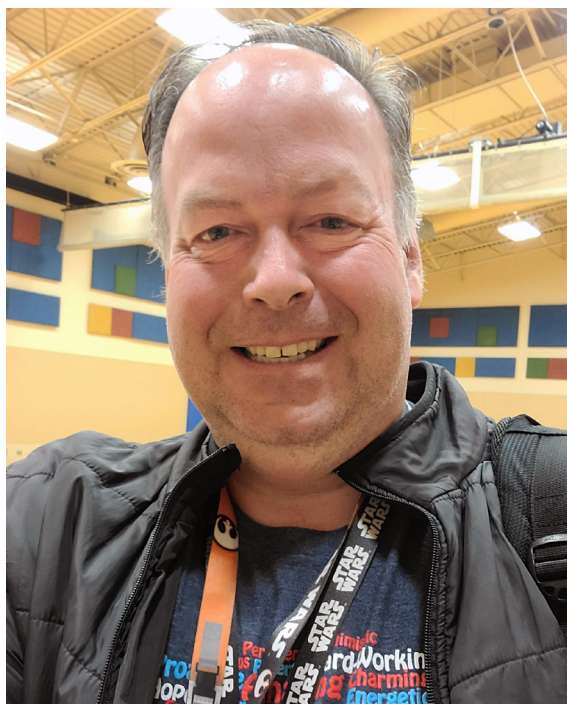

EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT

James McGregor, FULL-TIME SUBSTITUTE TEACHER

Mr. James McGregor graduated from Eastmont High School in 1990 and spent 14 years working as an industrial line mechanic and then a maintenance supervisor. After that, he worked in sales at a few media companies in the



valley before eventually taking a job as a paraeducator at Eastmont.

McGregor spent 10 years as a para and said he found working in education is something he really enjoyed.

"Over the years, I had several coworkers compliment me on my skills and suggest that I become a teacher," he wrote. "This encouragement to become a teacher came from all levels within the Eastmont School District."

In 2016, he started studying for a bachelor of arts degree in education and graduated with his teaching certificate in 2020. In 2021, he started working as a full-time district substitute.

McGregor said he's had many rewarding experiences while working in education, but there are two that stand out to him.

"The first one is when a student has entered the area of fully understanding what is being taught—that light bulb moment. It could be as simple as a

Health

COVID-19. We will be beginning our 2022-2023 school year with very similar COVID-19 safety protocols to last spring. A separate message detailing our district plans will be sent out via a ParentSquare message and within each school's first day of school communications.

The Washington State Department of Health has updated their guidance for schools, which can be reviewed at the following web links:

Social/Emotional/Mental Health Staff Additions.

The District has added an additional counselor at the junior high level (four total) and will be soon adding a second drug and alcohol prevention/intervention specialist.

Vaping Sensors. Equipment with sensors are being added to secondary school bathrooms which indicate when vaping fumes are present. The devices notify school administration of the location in real time. Our local teen vaping data is trending up (matching state/national trends) with tobacco and some THC/marijuana liquids being used. These sensors will help us determine which students need support and/or treatment, and reinforce with students that we are a drug-free/tobacco-free school.

Safety

School Resource Officers. The District is in the process of adding a second school resource officer (SRO) in partnership with the City of East Wenatchee Police Department. This additional officer will expand support to students at both junior high schools, Eastmont High School and some elementary school visits.

Security

Eastmont School District is enhancing our building security in the following ways:

Short Term: 1-3 months

- All exterior doors, including front entrances to schools, will be locked once school starts and continue to be locked until dismissal.
- Visiting students, parents and community members needing access to buildings while school is in session will be greeted by a staff member, use a bell/buzzer system, or be asked to call the front office with phone numbers clearly posted at each entrance to gain entry.
- This fall, all main school entrances will be equipped with cameras, two-way audio systems and remote access capabilities. Availability of equipment will require a delay in installation for some components.

Long Term: 1-2 years

A proposed bond (November 8, 2022) addresses structural changes to school buildings, including single points of entry/vestibules, perimeter fencing and other security-related improvements.

The Migrant Leadership Academy engages Migrant students in leadership strategies and training while gaining access to an ELA credit. This program encourages students to overcome obstacles and barriers to education while developing leadership qualities and school involvement. It was developed via a close partnership with our Association of Washington School Principals (AWSP) team. Oscar Lincoln from AWSP provided engaging lessons and team-building opportunities. The program includes a field experience in which students overcome an obstacle course. In addition, all seniors will be given the opportunity to sign up for Wenatchee Valley College.

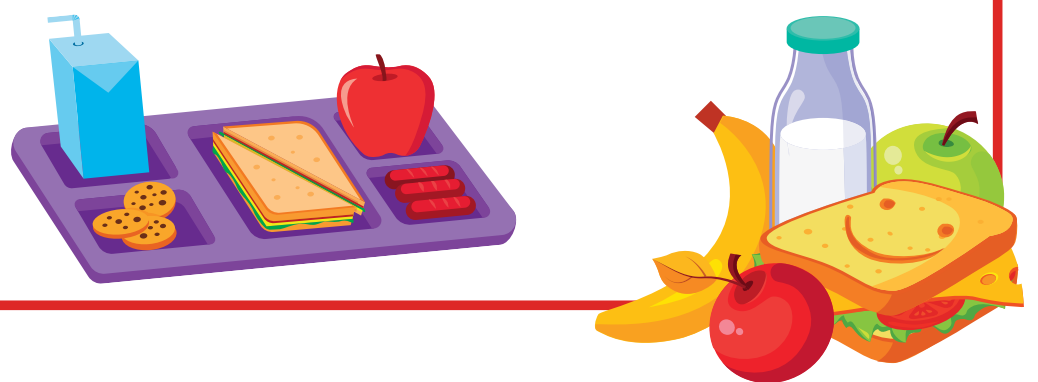
We know that some of our students, especially at the secondary level and those involved in activities, may want

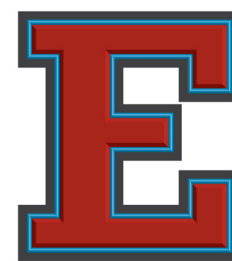

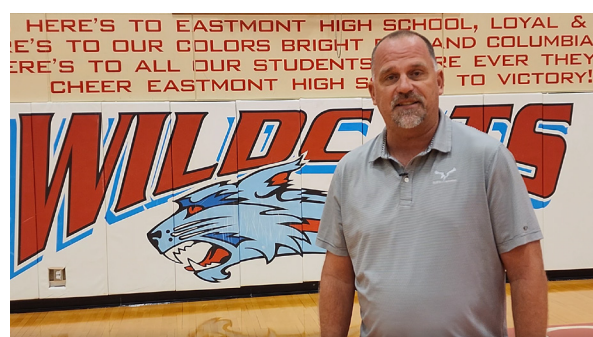

kindergartner understanding the sound that "th" makes as a digraph or an older student understanding "place value," all of those moments make working in education very rewarding," he wrote.

"The second fulfilling experience is when you see a student and all they can talk about is the class that you taught. Most of the time, this situation occurs with one of the students from an after-school STEM program I have taught over the years. I have taught 30+ individual

programs and this is one of the most fulfilling experiences that I really miss and hope to get back into in the future."

He said he'll keep looking for a full-time teaching position as he works as a full-time sub and that he'd like to get back into teaching STEM or STEAM classes

"I look forward to a future position where I can teach STEM, STEAM, coding, computer, science, and technology to students in a classroom setting," McGregor wrote.
