### What's the difference? Levy vs. Bond

tionships, Relevance, Rigor, Results



**Educational Programs & Operations (EP&O) Levy** = supports learning activities, elective/specialty courses, field trips, extracurricular activities and programs like art, drama, music and sports. <u>50% + 1 vote (simple majority)</u>

**Capital Levy** = smaller facility projects, repair and upgrade to infrastructure (roofs, HVAC, electrical, land acquisition). <u>50% + 1 vote (simple majority)</u>

**Bond** = larger facility projects, construction of schools, major remodels.  $\frac{60\% \text{ (super majority)}}{60\% \text{ (super majority)}}$




## **Taxpayer Impact**

What would this mean to me as a property owner?

- \$465,000 is the average/median home value in East Wenatchee.
- The 2023 increase in tax would be an estimated \$17.83 per month or \$214 a year more than in 2022.
- The projected total combined tax rate for 2025 is nearly \$1 per thousand *less* than in 2013.


