

UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM (UAS) DRONE AND MODEL AIRCRAFT

Definition

“Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS)” means an unmanned aircraft vehicle (drone), rocket, or wheeled vehicle that does not carry a human operator and can fly autonomously or remotely.

1. Personal, recreational, or unapproved commercial use of UAS/drones is prohibited on all campuses.
2. All use of UAS for student or adult instruction, videoing athletic practices, mapping, grounds and facility maintenance, campus security, and media or commercial use must be approved by the Superintendent/Designee.
3. Approved UAS operators will abide by all applicable local, state, and FAA safety guidelines and ensure drones are equipped with blade guards.
4. Approved media or commercial entities for the use of UAS will provide a release of liability to the District and provide proof of Certificate of Liability Insurance for a minimum of \$1,000,000 that names the Eastmont School District as an Additional Insured.
5. All photos/videos taken by staff, students, media, and commercial users during the use of UAS are the property of Eastmont School District unless otherwise approved.
