GRANT WRITING POLICY

The Eastmont School District Board of Directors recognizes the value of accessing resources from internal, as well as external funding streams. Grants can provide significant funding resources for programs and activities for staff and students. As a result, opportunities for learners are increased throughout our community.

Grants are soft money funds awarded by the government, a corporation, a family or a community for a specific purpose over a limited period of time. Grants are generally given to K-12 education for two basic purposes:

- 1. As seed money to start up new or innovative programs that improve student learning.
- 2. To facilitate reform or bring about change that will improve our work to get better results. The Eastmont School District recognizes that grants will not solve general funding issues, but that grants can help improve learning for students.

The superintendent or designee shall review all grant applications prior to submission to determine if these objectives are met.
